

Declaration of Compliance with Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014 - Russian Iron and Steel products

January 2026

In response to new regulations – Which came into force 30th September 2023 and will be rolled out in 3 phases, the last phase being implemented in Oct 2024 - regarding Russian Trade Sanctions and the banning of the import of certain iron and steel products which originate in Russia. Invertek have reached out to the relevant suppliers in order to declare our compliance in regard to the above regulations that are being rolled out over the next year.

Acknowledging the questions Invertek are receiving from our customers, this document serves as confirmation of Invertek's compliance regarding the Russian Iron and Steel Regulations, and to ensure that we will continue monitoring the situation closely.

We hereby confirm that our products do not contain Russian steel made from Russian Billets. Mill certification is no longer mandatory under the latest Directive and is replaced by this statement.
