Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (California Proposition 65)

Invertek Drives Ltd operates a modern office and manufacturing campus in Wales, United Kingdom, and has invested significantly in water-efficient technologies throughout both existing and newly developed facilities. Due to the nature of our manufacturing and service operations, water consumption associated with our processes remains relatively low.

Our landscaping strategy is designed to rely primarily on natural rainfall and benefits from a location with a low risk of flooding. As part of our ongoing commitment to environmental stewardship and biodiversity enhancement, we have established extensive areas of wildflower meadows, native hedgerows, and indigenous tree planting. These habitats are carefully selected to thrive within local environmental conditions, supporting biodiversity, strengthening ecosystem resilience, and creating a sustainable and attractive natural environment.

At Invertek Drives, we are committed to the responsible management of natural resources, including water. We continually seek opportunities to improve resource efficiency, minimise environmental impacts, prevent pollution, and protect the natural environment. Our Environmental Management System is certified to ISO 14001:2015, demonstrating our commitment to continual improvement, environmental responsibility, and compliance with applicable environmental legislation and obligations.

Invertek Drives designs and manufactures products in accordance with applicable regulatory and industry requirements. Our variable frequency drives are developed to recognised international standards for product safety, quality, reliability, and performance. Materials used in the manufacture of our products are selected with careful consideration for product integrity, environmental responsibility, and the reduction of potential health impacts wherever reasonably practicable.

California Proposition 65 Assessment

California Proposition 65 establishes Safe Harbor exposure levels for listed substances, including No Significant Risk Levels (NSRLs) for carcinogens and Maximum Allowable Dose Levels (MADLs) for substances known to cause reproductive toxicity. A Proposition 65 warning is generally not required where exposure remains at or below the applicable Safe Harbor threshold.

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Based on supplier declarations, material disclosures, technical assessments, and product information currently available to Inverterk Drives Ltd, we have not identified any reasonably foreseeable exposure scenario associated with the normal installation, operation, servicing, or intended use of our variable frequency drives that would be expected to exceed applicable Proposition 65 Safe Harbor exposure levels.

While Proposition 65-listed substances may be present in trace quantities within certain industrial electronic components or materials supplied by third parties, Inverterk Drives has no evidence to suggest that the intended use of our products results in exposures requiring a Proposition 65 warning under current legislation.

Commitment to Continuous Improvement

Inverterk Drives remains committed to sustainable business practices and the responsible management of environmental resources throughout our operations. We will continue to monitor applicable environmental regulations, evaluate opportunities to further improve water and resource efficiency, and maintain compliance with all relevant legal, regulatory, and customer requirements.
